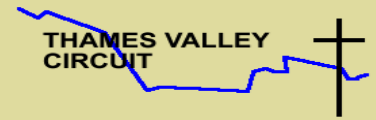

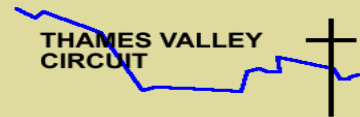

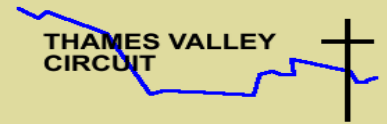

### Burnham

<b>Congregation:</b>	12 - 15.
<b>Children:</b>	A small number may be present.
<b>Books:</b>	Singing the Faith. Methodist Worship Book.  Yes; also printing facilities.
<b>CCL licence:</b>	Yes.  Good News.
<b>Worship Leaders:</b>	Pauline Poole
<b>Readers:</b>	Can be provided if prior notice is given.
<b>Notices:</b>	Given by Steward at commencement of service.
<b>Contact:</b>	Steward likes to have hymns and readings by Thursday evening.

### Colnbrook & Poyle

<b>Congregation:</b>	8 - 12.
<b>Children:</b>	Usually no children present.
<b>Books:</b>	Singing the Faith, Hymns & Psalms. Digital Hymnal usually available. Methodist Worship Book
<b>Projecting material:</b>	No.
<b>Bibles:</b>	Revised English Bibles (limited number) available.
<b>CCL licence:</b>	T V V Carols Service
<b>Worship Leaders:</b>	None.
<b>Readers:</b>	Available on request.
<b>Notices:</b>	Given at the beginning.
<b>Offertory:</b>	May be at any time.
<b>Contact:</b>	Sue Clifford
<b>Other:</b>	There is one Sunday service a month for Holy Communion Weekly worship takes place on Tuesdays at 10:30 am.

## Cookham Rise

<b>Congregation:</b>	About 15 - 20 in the morning, and 8 - 12 in the evening, mainly upper age range.
<b>Children:</b>	Children stay in Church and can move to a small table at the back where there is suitable material for them.
<b>Books:</b>	Singing the Faith (preferred), Songs of Fellowship (volumes 1 - 4) Words of other hymns can be printed off. Methodist Worship Book.
<b>CCL licence:</b>	54062
<b>Bibles:</b>	NIV available.
<b>Readers:</b>	At least one member of the congregation is available to read a lesson, or play some other part
<b>Notices:</b>	Available on printed sheet; any additional ones are given at the beginning of the service.
<b>Contact: Readers:</b>	A letter will be sent to the preacher 10 days before the service, usually by email, with details of Steward and Organist on duty. Hymns should be notified to the organist.
<b>Other:</b>	A screen, projector and laptop can be made available with sufficient notice.


## Hampshire Avenue, Slough

Congregation:	20 - 30
Children:	Present for opening worship; returning after Sermon.
Books:	Hymns & Psalms, Songs of Fellowship (used equally), Accompanied by Music Box. Methodist Worship Book
CCL licence:	Yes. Photocopying NOT available.
Bibles:	Good News (some available for congregagtion).
Worship Leaders:	Available on request,
Readers:	Readers are available on request to Steward / Secretary.
Notices:	Given by <u>steward</u> before the end of the service.
Contact:	Steward will telephone during previous week, or preacher to steward or secretary by Thursday.

## High Street, Maidenhead

<b>Congregation:</b>	10:30 am - about 70 - 80.
<b>Children:</b>	Children come in for the start of the 10:30 am service, and there is a children's address after the first hymn. For Parade Service they stay for the full service. Otherwise they go to their separate Junior Church after the Mothering Sunday Sunday afternoon in conjunction with St Mark's Crescent Church.
<b>Books:</b>	Singing the Faith (preferred), Songs of Fellowship. Hymns projected at morning service, hymn books used for other services. Methodist Worship Book.
<b>CCL licence:</b>	4890
<b>Bibles:</b>	Good News
<b>Worship Leaders:</b>	Yes.
<b>Readers:</b>	Available for all services, please confirm with Steward in advance.
<b>Bibles:</b>	Printed; any additional ones given at beginning of service.
<b>Contact:</b>	The e-mail for the preacher is usually sent 12 days ahead. Material for projection should be sent by Wednesday,
<b>Other:</b>	A projector is available for the 10:30 am service only. A parking space is reserved at the rear entrance in Nicholson's Lane. A headset or lapel microphone is provided, with sound controlled from sound desk. All 10.30 services are recorded for members unable to attend.

## Ledgers Road, Slough

<b>Congregation:</b>	About 30 - 50
<b>Children:</b>	2 - 12 (average 4 not regular) and Sunday School each week except for first Sunday. Children leave after the second hymn and usually come back to report their activities at the end of the service.
<b>Books:</b>	Singing the Faith, Hymns & Psalms, Mission Praise. Methodist Worship Book No projection or electronic music available.
<b>CCL licence:</b>	
<b>Bibles:</b>	Good News available for congregagtion.
<b>Worship Leaders:</b>	None
<b>Readers:</b>	Available via Steward.
<b>Notices:</b>	Read by Duty Steward; timing at the discretion of the preacher.
<b>Contact:</b>	Senior Steward.

## St Andrew's, Slough

<b>Congregation:</b>	10.30 about 40
<b>Children:</b>	Sometimes meet on Zoom, sometimes face to face. If present they leave after the first hymn.
<b>Books:</b>	Singing the Faith (preferred) Methodist Worship Book.
<b>CCL licence:</b>	63417
<b>Bibles:</b>	New Revised Standard Bible
<b>Worship Leaders</b>	There are four members of the congregation who are able to assist in the leading of worship. They can be contacted through the Steward on duty.
<b>Readers:</b>	There is a Readers' rota and the steward on duty will contact readers as required.
<b>Notices:</b>	Monthly newsletter. Any extra notices will be announced by the Steward before the service begins.

A letter will be sent to the preacher about 10 days before the service.  
It would be appreciated if the preacher, not later than the Thursday before the service, would send the Order of Service and any other information, including any pictures to be projected, to the duty steward not later than the Thursday before the service.  
The information will then be passed to the other people involved in the service.  
If a musician is not available the Singing the Faith CDs are used to accompany the singing.

## St Mark's Crescent, Maidenhead

<b>Congregation:</b>	am - typically 25 - 30; pm - around 10 Messy Church - about 6 families, mostly young children.
<b>Children:</b>	No Junior Church, but activities for children are provided in the church.
<b>Books:</b>	Singing the Faith, Songs of Fellowship (Book 1), Hymns & Psalms All hymns normally projected, with paper copies available as necessary Hymns can be played through computer or from CD if required. Methodist Worship Book
<b>CCL licence:</b>	54062
<b>Bibles:</b>	Good News <input type="text"/>
<b>Worship Leaders:</b>	Mrs Eileen Chislett
<b>Readers:</b>	There is a readers' rota and the Steward on duty will make arrangements
<b>Notices:</b>	Printed, but also available on line Offeratory when preacher wishes; Benevolence Fund collection during Communion hymn.
<b>Contact:</b>	A letter will be sent about two weeks before the service giving contact details for the Steward on duty. The Steward will make contact on Wednesday or Thursday prior to the service for Hymns (needed for Friday afternoon practice) and reading.
<b>Other:</b>	Modern form of Lord's Prayer is preferred. Lapel and hand held microphones with static microphones on lectern and pulpit. Hearing loop. DVDs can be projected. CD player and Mini disk player.

## Windsor

<b>Congregation:</b>	Morning service about 30 - 45; evening service about 6 - 15.
<b>Children:</b>	25 on register, Children's talk appreciated. The first 2 hymns and prayers to be child-appropriate. Lord's Prayer should be included whilst children are present. Leave with a blessing after second hymn.
<b>Books:</b>	Singing the Faith (preferred), Songs of Fellowship (combined). Hymns can be projected by arrangement, given sufficient notice. Methodist Worship Book.
<b>CCL licence:</b>	121490
<b>Bibles:</b>	Today's NIV
<b>Worship Leaders</b>	Yes
<b>Readers:</b>	Available for Morning Service via Steward
<b>Notices:</b>	Printed, with additional notices given at the beginning of the Service Offertry when the Preacher directs.
<b>Other:</b>	In sanctuary; hearing system - need to use headset provided, In Falder Hall - loop system. Organ, electronic keyboard and piano for some services. (Please enquire if we have an organist/pianist available), otherwis Hymnal Plus.CD/DVD player/recorder available. Lapel radio microphone, with static microphones on lectern and pulpit. Power Point can be incorporated if slides/hymns are sent at least one week before the service.
